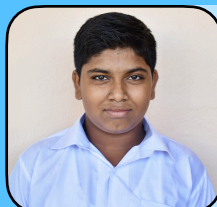
“Wishing you all the very best for this academic year,” ended the Principal.

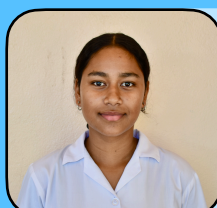

I was a bit nervous at first but overall I felt good to be in SVC.



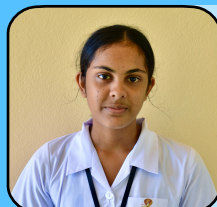
